The Spring 2011 VGCA Gun Show will be at the Prince William County Fairgrounds on March 26-27, 2011. Pass the word and remember that flyers for the fall show will be at this meeting so plan to spread a few around. Good places to ask to leave them are barbershops and other small businesses.

- Spring VGCA Gun Show Sales Tables: Calling all members!!! The Association still has tables remaining for the Spring VGCA Gun Show. Members who wish to reserve a table for disposing of your unloved or duplicate firearms, accoutrements, collectable accessories, or other gun collecting related items, please contact Rick Nahas, ASAP. If you believe manning a sales table alone would be too demanding and not allow you time to hunt for deals or just talk to other members, get a partner and share the duties and have relief for your time around the show. Show tables cost \$60 each, so share the costs with a colleague.




