action 12g shotgun. According to various sources, including Doug Wickland, this was one of the first examples of a manufacture's recall since it was designed by John Browning for Black Powder 12g Shells and by 1897, higher pressure

smokeless 12g shells had entered the market. Consequently, the Winchester Model 1893 shotgun was a redesigned to handle the new ammunition and designated

the Winchester Model 1897 shotgun. Member 2 presented a



Walther Model P88 semi-automatic 9mm pistol produced in 1988. What made this particular pistol interesting is that it was held by the Walther factory for in-house usage until finally released for sale in 1995 (check this date) and is so marked. Member 3 brought a Ruger 44 magnum semi-automatic rifle, produced from

1961 to 1985. It was, and still is a popular deer rifle in states that still allow semi-automatic rifles for such purposes. Member 3 presented a sporterized Norwegian Krag rifle in 6.5x55 Swede.
