June 2016 VGCA Newsletter

O VGCA Meeting of May 26, 2016:

Our May presentation was from Mike Cogswell, who spoke on the subject of Navy P04 Lugers. He explained how the Navy Lugers were different from their German Army counterparts and why. He punctuated his informative presentation with several outstanding examples from his collection, including one of the initial 150 produced as Imperial German Navy trials guns.



Mike not only talked about the technical aspects of P04, to include the various changes, adaptations, and improvements incorporated during production, but also covered their employment within the context of the rapidly expanding German Navy before and during World War I. He provided background into the various specialties among German Naval personnel, their schools and their training. Taking advice from his wife on the benefits of "accessorizing," Mike showed examples of the contemporary German cutlass, period photographs showing sailors wearing their Luger rigs, and sailor training books documenting their initial qualification on the P04.
